**An Important Reminder about the Club's COVID-19 protocols
FOR COLD AND FLU SEASON & FOR
STUDENTS AND OTHERS VISITING FROM OVERSEAS**

Dear Members of the ACC Community,

As cold and flu season is now upon us, we ask you to avoid coming to the Club if you are suffering from any cold or flu symptoms, no matter how mild. By behaving responsibly in this way, you will help preserve the ACC as a safe haven for Members, their families and our staff – particularly for those most at risk in our community – during the months ahead.

Mandatory quarantine for those who have traveled outside of Taiwan or who have family members, guests or domestic helpers who have

As was the case at spring break time, we are writing to remind everyone that any family members, house guests or domestic helpers who have come from overseas must remain in quarantine for 14 days before coming to the Club. In addition, Members and their families who reside with visitors from overseas as outlined above must also stay away from the Club until the 14-day quarantine period has been successfully completed. These requirements are consistent with the commitments Members made when completing the One-Time Travel and Health Self-Declaration form and have been implemented to ensure that the Club remains a safe home away from home for the entire ACC community. We are confident that we can do so with the understanding and cooperation of our considerate and responsible membership.



It is recommended but not mandatory to wear masks at ACC

A note of thanks to Members of all ages who cooperated with the previous requirement to wear masks when visiting the Club. After two weeks of observation, we are now ending the mandatory mask requirement, but continue to recommend mask-wearing for your safety and others when in close proximity indoors. Enhanced sanitation measures remain in place

Throughout the COVID-19 period, the Club's housekeeping staff have been continuing their enhanced cleaning programs, which includes regular sanitizing of fixtures and surfaces with an alcohol-based solution. Additional alcohol dispensers have been provided throughout the clubhouse and more have been ordered for the Fitness Center. The after hours "fogging" by outside contractors has been resumed due to the spike in COVID-19 cases in Taiwan.

At its November meeting, the Board of Governors appointed a new COVID-19 Taskforce consisting of David Brightling, Pradeep Mehrotra, Maria Ting and Dr. Ming Chi Yung. This group monitors the changing COVID-19 situation in Taiwan and develops new policies and protocols in a timely fashion to respond to changing circumstances and to keep our ACC community safe.
