



Coronavirus Update

The Club's coronavirus measures remain in effect and we continue to monitor and follow government health guidelines.

Members who have travelled to – or whose family have travelled to – countries now designated as Level 2 (Iran, Italy, Japan, Singapore and Thailand) within the past 14 days may visit the Club but must wear masks and follow government guidelines for self-monitoring. Hong Kong, Macau and China are still classified as Level 3 risks and Members, their family and friends who may have visited them must follow the government's self-quarantine requirements. South Korea has recently been added to the Level 3 category and any Member who has travelled to South Korea – or whose family members have – must enter a full quarantine program. The cooperation of all Members with these government requirements will ensure that the ACC remains a safe home away from home for its Members and their families.
