



COVID-19 UPDATE

The coronavirus situation remains a very fluid and fast changing one.

At the time of writing, China, Hong Kong, Iran, Italy, Macau and South Korea have been designed as “Level 3” countries and hundreds of Taiwanese have been flown home from Wuhan, the epicenter of the outbreak. Anyone who has travelled from a Level 3 country must enter a full quarantine program.

Level 2 countries include Austria, Bahrain, Belgium, Denmark, France, Germany, Iceland, Japan, Kuwait, the Netherlands, Norway, Singapore, Spain, Sweden and Switzerland. Anyone returning from Level 2 countries must observe a 14-day period of self-health management.

Members visiting the Club during this period are doing so on the basis that they are following all government guidelines on quarantine and self-health management and their use of the Club is their legal representation to this effect.



CLUB MEASURES

We continue to monitor – and react to – information provided by the government and are also in touch with reciprocal clubs in the region and with the local hotel industry. Between Board meetings, our COVID-19 measures are developed by the Executive Committee and the Management team.

Our guiding principle is to do all that we can to protect the health of our Members, their children and our staff.

Our interim measures are not perfect and are constantly being fine-tuned as new information becomes available and as Members provide their feedback. We trust that you will understand if we are on the side of caution in our response to this epidemic. The temporary ban on guests will be in effect from Tuesday March 17th until Monday April 13th, as outlined below. The slight delay in implementing the ban was to ensure that all Members were informed (via e-news and through an insert with the monthly account statements for those who do not open their e-news) and to give everyone time to make alternate arrangements. This will be reviewed at our March Board meeting.

We ask for your patience, understanding and cooperation as we strive to preserve the ACC as a safe home away from home for its Members, their children and our staff
