



COVID-19 related enforcement measures to keep Club safe

The Board of Governors have approved and enacted the following special measures with regards to Members to deal with the COVID-19 situation.

1. Members who have traveled abroad within 14 days or live with those who have may not use the Club.
2. Members must be in compliance with any Taiwan Centers for Disease Control requirements that apply to them.
3. The ACC during this time is for Members only – no guests or domestic caregivers.
4. Mandatory temperature checks are required upon entering.
5. On each visit, Members must sign the travel declaration at the entrance.



The Constitution requires the Board to make sure the Club is acting in accordance with all laws and regulations – especially those enacted recently by the Taiwan government to mitigate the effects of the COVID-19 virus. Further, it is the responsibility of the Board and management to provide a safe environment for Members, their children and our staff. The Board believes the new restrictions cannot serve these purposes unless violators can be dealt with swiftly and in accordance with these restrictions.

Therefore, the Board of Governors temporarily grants General Manager David Brightling the authority to suspend, on its behalf, the memberships of any Member who acts to circumvent any of the above safety measures. This would apply to the Member involved and to all Members in the household. All suspensions would be immediate and can be appealed at the next scheduled Board of Governors meeting.

I am saddened to report the first family suspensions have already been issued.
